The Governors of Hessle High school have a clearly defined policy requiring all students, other than those in the Sixth Form, to wear the approved school uniform at school, on the way to and from school, and at any school function where it is considered appropriate.

The wearing of uniform encourages the student to feel a sense of pride and belonging to the school community. The wearing of uniform also sets clear expectations to ensure health and safety and a good working environment for all students. In addition, the inclusive ethos of the school places a high priority on equality.

The school will make every effort to ensure the policy is consistently and fairly applied.

The school reserves the right to determine whether a student's dress and appearance is acceptable. Students who are not wearing correct uniform should expect to be challenged and dealt with accordingly.

Sweatshirt or V Neck Jumper	With school logo only. No cardigans
Shirt	Plain white. Loose fitting with pointed shirt style collar.
Polo shirt – Summer term only	White with school gold logo only.
Tie	School tie must be worn with a shirt. A tie need not be worn with school polo shirt during summer term.
Trousers	Plain black, full length, waist high, straight leg, tailored trousers. Cords, jeans, denim, ski pants/leggings, tight fitting, combat style or linen trousers are not permitted. A thin black belt, with a small buckle, may be worn.
Skirt	Plain black, flared, pleated or 'A' line. No splits. No lycra, clingy or stretchy fabric.
Tights	Flesh coloured or plain black with no patterns.

Footwear	Plain black with low heel. No black trainers, open sandals, mules or fashion boots. Laces should be tied.
Outdoor coat	Serviceable and sensible. Expensive designer coats should not be worn. All outdoor clothing must be removed for lessons and in dining areas.
Hats	Hats or caps must not be worn inside the school building.
Jewellery/Piercing	One small, metal stud may be worn in each ear. No other jewellery or studs in body piercing should be worn.
Make-up	Should not be worn in school.
Hair styles	Hair should be broadly of even length overall. Short styles are acceptable provided hair is of an even length. Hair should be of a natural colour and in an appropriate style. Unnatural coloured hair, stripes, mohican or mohawk styles are not permitted.
Y12 and Y13	Students are expected to observe appropriate standards of dress when attending school, bearing in mind that they are studying with adolescents.
Indoor PE Kit	Plain white T-shirt, black shorts, white socks. It is not compulsory to buy these items from the school although they must be plain. No outdoor shoes shall be worn for indoor activities.
Outdoor PE Kit	Rugby shirt, black shorts, navy socks. School hooded top with the logo may be worn at Heads Lane only. Tracksuit bottoms may be worn as well as school kit, not instead of, from October half term to February half term. Tracksuit bottoms must be black or navy. Football boots should be worn for hockey, rugby and football. In the summer term, indoor kit shall be worn for outdoor activities.
