**At Peshurst Primary School we believe that children learn best when they have clear rewards and sanctions for their day to day conduct in and around school. If children feel safe and can enjoy their lessons then they will learn.**

#### **Classroom Rules**

In Class ....., we.....

1. Respect our own, other peoples and school's property.
2. Are always kind, helpful and polite.
3. Always do our best work and have a positive attitude.
4. Always listen to others, join in appropriately, and put our hand up when we want to share with the class.
5. Keep our hands and feet to ourselves and respect others personal space.
6. Move sensibly and safely around the classroom.

#### **School rules**

In our school, we.....

1. Follow the 'S' lining up rule
  - Single file
  - Straight line
  - Silently
  - Sensibly
  - And always with a smile
2. Walk on the left hand side of the corridor.
3. Are polite and show good manners to everyone we meet.
4. Only go in a room when an adult is there.

#### **Reward System**

- Penguins will be handed out daily for all types of good behaviour and academic progress and attainment.

- At the end of the day, children count their penguins and the one/s with the most get a penguin sticker that is stuck on the class team chart.
- Individual children will be rewarded in assembly with certificates (5s, 10s etc).
- Head of School will reward further by children taking certificate to him and choosing a prize from his 10, 20 basket etc.
- Friday Parent Assembly, invites parents into school to witness their children's achievement.

- During Friday assembly the team with the winning number of penguins for that week will be announced. The winning team then stand up in assembly and are receive applause and the team trophy for that week.
- Each week on the team board team totals are updated.
- There will be a cup displayed at the bottom of the board with a placard next to it with the current weeks winners.
- At the end of the year, there is a special assembly where the winning team is announced and celebrated. A cup is presented and this will be engraved and displayed in the entrance foyer.

Stage 1	Repeatedly ignoring / breaking class and school rules	3 strike system Loss of Golden Time (5 min increments) More than 15 mins, report to DH - Head of School ( <b>move to Stage 2 - Yellow Report</b> )
Stage 2	Challenge to adult authority Use of abusive language to cause offence Bullying Deliberately creating a disturbance Leaving classroom without permission Playground Fights	Yellow Report (2 <sup>nd</sup> yellow report card in a term = red report)  <b>Contact Made with Home</b>
Stage 3	Repeated Bullying Vandalism Intentional Violent Behaviour Stealing Any toxic substance on school premises	Red Report <b>(Lunch time exclusion Head to Supervise)</b>

**Exclusion = Extreme Violence / Serious Challenge to Authority / Physical Abuse to staff - children**

**Two Red Reports in One Term = 1 day exclusion**
